<b>Four Springs Lake Preserve</b>	Loop Trail, <b>BWH</b> Entrance beds weeded <b>BWH</b> Pond Beds weeded and watered Parking beds weeded, planted  Main kiosk with brochure box, kiosk at trail head with brochure box, clean kiosk on Holton Trail
<b>Iverson Spit Preserve</b>	Loop Trail; 3 sets of Steps over Dike; North section of trail to Bridge;  Main kiosk (two sides); brochure box; 2 ground standing kiosks to clean on boardwalk.
<b>Ivy/Drylake Road Trailhead Park</b>	Short trail and picnic area; Kiosk (two sides); Brochure Box
<b>Kristoferson Beaver Marsh &amp; Creek Habitat</b>	Keep growth under control, report vandalism, check creek often. Kiosk (two sides); Brochure Box
<b>Terry's Corner</b>	Brochure box at the flower garden (shared with BWH)
<b>Utsalady Vista Park</b>	3 bedding areas weed & Cut back and rake; Brochure box
<b>Walt Hutchinson Park</b>	Cut grass, trim loop trail, report downed trees
